Personal Care

"Personal care services" means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident's needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows: Tube Feeding, 1 on 1 Assistance with Feeding, Puree Diet, Renal Diet,

2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows: Assist client with pivot transfer to the toilet, provide commode in the bedroom when requested. Assist with wiping, cleaning, changing incontinent pads, assist with personal hygiene to ↓ UTI.

3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows: Standby Assistance with Ambulation Provide escort when jogging outside the facility

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows: Transfer using Hoyer Lift, 1 or 2 person transfer (pivot transfer), transfer using sliding board, transfer using Serru Lift, Assistance with all transfer including Hoyer Lift.

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows: Full Repositioning assistance every 2 to 3 hours especially bed bound client who are not able to move or scoot up on bed.

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows: Assist brushing teeth, comb hair, file fingernails, change dirty incontinent diapers, wash face, sponge baths, give showers, apply lotion, do foot care, nail care, do wash perineal area, wipe bottom.

7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows: Assistance with dressing if client is unable to do the task, pick appropriate clothing if client is unable based on type of weather condition

8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows: Assistance with shower 2x a week or daily accdg. to client's preference or sponge baths if client is HOSPICE CARE or if client is bed bound.

Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is: Medication Administration using

Bubble Packs, Eye Drop Administration, Topical Cream application, Patch application, Nasal Spray Administration, ENEMA administration as long as there is RN Delegation. Established with the Pharmacist, Call Pharmacy for medication refills, Do FAXES to Pharmacy re: New Rx & Changes of new medications.

Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. (WAC 388-76-10405)

The home provides the following skilled nursing services: *RN DELEGATION TASKS prior to doing the delegated tasks: Tube Feeding, Insulin Injection, Topical Cream Application, Eye Drops application, ENEMAS, NASAL SPRAY, SIMPLE WOUND CARE.*

The home has the ability to provide the following skilled nursing services by delegation: *INSULIN INJECTION, TUBE FEEDING, EYE DROPS, TOPICAL CREAM APPLICATION, ENEMAS, NASAL SPRAY, SIMPLE WOUND CARE, COLOSTOMY CARE*
