## Personal Care

"Personal care services" means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident's needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

### 1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

**We provide 3 meals and 3 snacks daily for all resident(s) and we also provide on an as needed basis for care takers to assist with feeding our clients that needs assistance.**

### 2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

**We assist our resident(s) on an as needed basis; walking them to the bathroom, positioning them on the toilet, monitoring them, and assist with cleaning after the use of the toilet. i.e; cleaning the perea area and washing their hands.**

### 3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

**Standby assist with walker**

### 4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

**Utilizing transfer belts or hoyer lifts.**

### 5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

**Clients are assisted with repositioning on an as needed basis or PRN.**

### 6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

**Combing hair, brushing their teeth or dentures, washing face/hands with warm washcloths and soap and putting lotion.**

### 7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:

**Caregiver will assist residents on an as needed basis.**

### 8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:

**Caregiver will assist resident(s) on an as needed basis.**

### 9. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CARE

## Medication Services

- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.
