<p>2. TOILETING          If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:  <b>Reminders, supervision, monitoring, cueing, physical help, total dependence as per care plan.</b></p>
<p>3. WALKING          If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:  <b>Supervision, stand by assist, assist client with mobility aids.</b></p>
<p>4. TRANSFERRING          If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:  <b>1-person assist, 1-2 person assist, using hooyer lift and other transferring device.</b></p>
<p>5. POSITIONING          If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:  <b>Supervision, prompting, Reposition every 2 hours as needed per care plan.</b></p>
<p>6. PERSONAL HYGIENE          If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:  <b>Shaving (head, mustache, beard), trimming hair, nails, toenails(non diabetic), brushing teeth, etc.</b></p>
<p>7. DRESSING          If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:  <b>Supervise, monitor, cue, partial help and total dependence assistance.</b></p>
<p>8. BATHING          If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:  <b>Supervise, monitor, prompting, cueing, partial help, total dependence assistance.</b></p>
<p>9. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CARE  <b>Staff will ask client to participate on his/her personal care.</b></p>
<b>Medication Services</b>
