**IMPOSITION OF CONDITIONS ON A LICENSE,
RESCIND SUMMARY SUSPENSION, REVOCATION OF LICENSE
AND STOP PLACEMENT ORDER PROHIBITING ADMISSIONS
(AMENDING ENFORCEMENT NOTICE DATED OCTOBER 24, 2013)**

Dear Licensee:

On October 24, 2013, the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), Residential Care Services conducted an inspection/investigation at your facility. In an Enforcement Notice dated October 25, 2013, DSHS gave you formal notice of the summary suspension, revocation of the adult family home license and stop placement of admissions for your adult family home, also known as A Plus Home, located at 4919 30th Avenue South, Seattle, by the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services. These actions are taken under the authority granted in Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 70.128.160, chapter 43.20A RCW, and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 388-76-10940.

Pursuant to the terms of a Stipulation and Agreed Order of Dismissal entered on April 22, 2014, DSHS hereby rescinds the summary suspension, revocation of the adult family home license and stop placement of admissions for your adult family home, and imposes conditions based on the following violation of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) regulations found by DSHS at your adult family home. These deficiencies are more fully described in the attached amended Statement of Deficiencies dated October 24, 2013 completed by DSHS.

WAC 388-76-10620(1) Resident rights—Quality of life—General.

The licensee failed to ensure that staff promoted care for one resident in a manner that maintained the resident's dignity and respect of his individuality.

DSHS has determined that the following conditions shall be placed on your adult family home based on the findings of the inspection and the above-referenced violation:


- a) *The licensed provider, Jocelyn Hernandez shall complete the following trainings within six (6) weeks with a DSHS approved provider:*
 - 1) *Dementia Manager Specialty Training, and*
 - 2) *Mental Health Manager Specialty Training;*
- b) *Cesar Hernandez shall complete the following trainings with a DSHS approved provider prior to working as a caregiver in the adult family home:*
 - 3) *Dementia Manager Specialty Training, and*
 - 4) *Mental Health Manager Specialty Training;*
- c) *The licensed provider, Jocelyn Hernandez, and her spouse, Cesar Hernandez, shall review all topics under the Adult Abuse and Prevention section of the Adult Long Term Support Administration's (AL TSA) website at www.altas.dshs.wa.gov and take and submit evidence of completion of the test associated with the Mandatory Reporter Training section;*
- d) *The licensed provider, Jocelyn Hernandez, and her spouse, Cesar Hernandez shall attest in writing that they each have read the Adult Family Home "Guidebook: Prevention, Recognition, Resident Protection, and Mandated Reporting" located at www.altsa.dshs.wa.gov/professional and must print and maintain a hard copy of this document in the Adult Family Home and have readily available for all staff to read;*
- e) *The licensed provider, Jocelyn Hernandez shall develop a new caregiver orientation training plan that includes training for all caregivers about recognizing abuse, abuse prevention, protection of residents from abuse, and mandated reporting consistent with the training materials referenced in paragraphs b & c above;*
- f) *The provider shall not admit any residents into this home until the training requirements set forth above in paragraphs (c), (d) and (e) are completed;*
- g) *The licensee must post this Notice of Conditions with the license in a visible location in a common use area.*

These conditions are effective on April 23, 2014 in agreement with the settlement.
