A dedicated staff assists and monitors residents while respecting their independence and privacy. We specialize in mental health, dementia care, and providing services to those who cannot live alone. Residents may include those with developmental disabilities, memory loss, mental health issues, veterans, and others needing reminding and guiding. We monitor medications, assist with activities of daily living, provide culturally appropriate home cooked meals, and take residents on outings and mini vacations.</p>

<p>“Personal care services” means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident’s needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)</p>

<p>If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows: -Chopping or pureeing food as prescribed, monitoring for choking, one on one feedings with eating utensils, and encouraging residents to eat according to their prescribed diets.</p>
<p>2. TOILETING</p> <p>If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows: -Reminding and guiding to use the toilet, and assistance with hygiene after toileting.</p>
<p>3. WALKING</p> <p>If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows: -Providing hands on support when needed for walking, accompanying residents on short walks, and reminding residents to walk. Cartier's can not accommodate nonambulatory residents.</p>
<p>4. TRANSFERRING</p> <p>If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows: -Residents who are weak or recovering from illness will be provided limited transfer assistance while they regain or work towards regaining their strength. Potential residents will be evaluated on a case by case bases for suitability in relation to transferring. Cartier's cannot accommodate residents requiring full transfer.</p>
<p>5. POSITIONING</p> <p>If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows: -Cartier's AFH does not provide assistance with positioning. If a resident becomes ill and requires such assistance, Cartier's will accommodate on a short term basis while the care needs of the resident is reevaluated, and subsequent placement sought, if needed.</p>
<p>6. PERSONAL HYGIENE</p> <p>If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows: -Cartier's AFH provides reminding, guiding, cueing, and assistance to residents to ensure their personal hygiene needs are met.</p>
