"Personal care services" means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident's needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)	

1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows: ~~Provide~~ 3 meals + 2 snacks a day assist residents according to their needs from no assistance at all to total assistance including cutting foods, feeding, cueing based on their care plan + assessment

2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows: again based on their assessment, depending on the needs of the resident. toilet resident to bathroom every 2 hrs + as needed, give post-care, change depend if soiled, cueing to use bathroom

3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows: depending on the needs of the resident we provide, stand by assist, walking + holding one hand to ensure safety, direct resident where to go + keep on eye on them, make sure environment (pathway) are clear of clutter

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows: depending on their care assessment we provide transferring fr. bed to wheelchair, wheelchair to chair, cueing, stand by assist, using proper techniques

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows: our caregivers are well trained to positioning + reposition resident as needed, turning resident every two hrs + as needed, putting pillows inbetween legs as needed.

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows: brushing teeth, dentures care, washing face, comb hair, cutting fingernails + toenails as needed applying lotion on lower + upper extremities

7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows: depending on needs + capabilities little to complete assistance + dressing provided, this includes putting bras, socks, shoes, clothes upper + lower, and picking the right clothes for the resident.

8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows: from checking the right water temperature, total assist throughout bath. Getting in + out of shower, shampoo hair, scrubbing back + areas as needed, drying after shower

9. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CARE

Evergreen AFH is delighted in providing assistance with the personal care to our residents, ranging from little to no assistance up to complete/full assistance depending on the needs + preferences of our residents

Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. (WAC 388-76-10430)

The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is: Per. Physicians orders or per prescription only. Oral medications must be administered by putting on cup + given to resident due to take the meds. Cough medicine + put on apple sauce or pudding + MD order

Our staff are nurse, delegated + trained to administer medication or provide assistance with their medication per MD orders.

Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. (WAC 388-76-10405)

The home provides the following skilled nursing services: applying topical ointment, eye drops oxygen use, resident is insulin dependant, catheter ^{can} only be ^{done} if it is delegated by RN
