

NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

January 25, 2019

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **January 10, 2019**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of **BEECEE HOMES INC**, License #750815, located at **931 12th Ave N, Edmonds, Washington**.

- *The Adult Family Home (AFH) Provider, at the provider's own expense, must hire a Registered Nurse Consultant (RNC) not currently or previously affiliated with the adult family home, to assist the Provider to develop and implement a system to ensure skin care needs and pain management for end of life residents care needs are met. This will include but is not limited to:*
 - *Causes of pressure sores/ulcers.*
 - *Identification of residents at risk for pressure ulcers.*
 - *What to do if skin problems are identified.*
 - *Required reporting.*
 - *Identify which skin care tasks require nurse delegation.*
 - *How to promote healthy skin.*
 - *Pain management.*
 - *Recording of routine and prescribed medications.*
 - *Updating the care plan.*
 - *All caregivers and the AFH provider must be trained.*
- *The RNC must be hired by February 8, 2019. The consultant will be available to answer questions from the department.*
- *The AFH Provider will provide a report from the consultant, signed by the provider regarding what was trained and when completed to the department by February 28, 2019.*
- *The AFH Provider will provide the consultant a copy of the January 10, 2019, Statement of Deficiencies (SOD).*
- *The Adult Family Home provider will post the Notice of Conditions in the Adult Family Home, with the license, in a location accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **January 25, 2019**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.



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
