## Personal Care

“Personal care services” means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident’s needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

### 1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

**An individualized plan of care with a dual objectives of providing adequate food and fluid intake and maintaining clients self feeding ability as possible. AFH provides monitoring and total assistance depending on residents needs.**

### 2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

**Home Sweet Home AFH put safety First. Provide cuing and monitoring in toileting. This includes cleaning and changing residents when needed.**

### 3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

**Home Sweet Home Adult Family home provide assistance in walking client inside and outside the Adult family home. This includes assisting them using a walker ,gait belt or any other assistive device that can help a resident to walk safely with 1 or 2 caregiver assist.**

### 4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

**Well trained caregiver to make sure that caregiver and resident are both safe during and after Tranferring. AFH uses walker,sliding board or Electric hoyer during transferring with 1 or 2 caregiver assist.**

### 5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

**Frequent repositioning a resident to prevent pressure ulcer to all client that cannot reposition their self alone.**

### 6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

**Caregiver assist residents in Brushing their teeth, combing their hair,trimming nails,washing their face and shaving.**

### 7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:

**Residents should be dressed in their own clean, comfortable clothing everyday. Resident who walks should wear appropriate foot wear and non-ambulatory should have suitable foot coverings on when out of bed.**

### 8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:

**Home Sweet Home AFH offers bathing/Showering according to their desired time to all resident.**

### 9. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CARE

**For diabetic client, a Registered Nurse come to the AFH and trim their nails.**

## Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is:

**AFH provide assistance in giving only prescribed medication and document it with time, date and Dosage.**

**Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation**

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. (WAC 388-76-10405)

The home provides the following skilled nursing services:

**Medication administration, nurse delegation ,tube feed feeding and catheters.**

The home has the ability to provide the following skilled nursing services by delegation:

**Glucose monitoring, Topicals,inhalation and insulin.**

#### **Staffing**

- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.

The normal staffing levels for the home are:

- Registered nurse, days and times: **Only as needed**
- Licensed practical nurse, days and times: **Only as needed**
- Certified nursing assistant or long term care workers, days and times: **24 hours**
- Awake staff at night
