

Based on interview and record review, the adult family home failed to ensure all caregivers cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid certification was kept valid when Caregiver A's certification was expired according to interview and not kept for record review. Failure to ensure valid CPR and first aid certification placed all residents at risk of receiving care in an emergent situation by an unqualified person.


Findings include:

All interviews and record review were conducted on 12/21/2018 unless otherwise noted.

Record review of Caregiver A's administrative record review revealed no CPR or first aid training. Caregiver A stated that she had CPR and first aid training but believed that it expired in March of 2018. Caregiver A also stated that she does not have a copy of the old training. The Provider he stated an appointment would be made immediately in order to complete the first aid and CPR training.
