## Personal Care

“Personal care services” means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident’s needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

### 1. EATING

**We provide assistance for eating as needed for each individual, from independent to complete assistance or feeding tube. We can customize diets for diabetic, puree or most needs.**

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

**Our home caters from independent individuals to complete and total care individuals.**

### 3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

**Our home can provide assistance from limited to extensive assistance with walking and assistive devices.**

### 4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

**Our home can provide assistance from limited to extensive assistance with transferring with devices such as hoist lifts, or 2 person transfers if needed.**

## Medication Services

**Staffing**

- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.
