WAC 388-76-10025 License annual fee.

- (1) The adult family home must pay the license fee that is established in the state's operating budget, as described in RCW 70.128.060 .
- (2) Each year, the home's annual license fee is due during the same month in which the home was initially licensed. For example, if the home was licensed in June, 2010, then the annual licensing fee will be due in June of each year.
- (3) The home must ensure that the department receives the annual license fee when it is due.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based Observation, interview and record review, the adult family home (AFH) failed to pay their annual license fee, which was due 09/15/2017. This failure resulted in the AFH operating with invalid license since 09/15/2017.

Finding includes:


During unannounced visit to the AFH, five residents (R#1, R#2, R#3, and R#4) lived and received care from the AFH.

Review of the Department's records on 11/27/2017, revealed the AFH was licensed on 09/24/2007 and had not paid the annual licensing fee of \$1350.00 due 09/15/2017, (oldest due date).

During interview, the Provider said they were not aware the fee had not paid. The Provider said they totally missed this payment, and will be corrected.
