

WAC 388-76-10025 License annual fee.

- (1) The adult family home must pay the license fee that is established in the state's operating budget, as described in RCW 70.128.060 .
- (2) Each year, the home's annual license fee is due during the same month in which the home was initially licensed. For example, if the home was licensed in June, 2010, then the annual licensing fee will be due in June of each year.
- (3) The home must ensure that the department receives the annual license fee when it is due.
- (4) If the home does not pay the fee when it is due, the department will impose remedies.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation, interview, and record review, the adult family home failed to pay annual license fee as required. The deficient practice placed residents at risk of living in an unlicensed home. Findings included...

On 02/26/19 at 11:20 AM, the home had six residents that required care and services from the adult family home staff. Per observation, the home had working electricity, running water, adequate food storage, and supplies needed for resident care. Residents were groomed and clothed appropriately. Residents and Caregivers were interviewed and had no concerns related to availability of supplies.


Review of the home's licensing file on 02/26/19 showed the annual license fee was due 12/15/18 but had not been paid. The annual fee was over two months past due.

The Provider was interviewed per telephone on 02/26/19 at 11:25 AM, stated that he thought he'd paid the fee and would review his financial records. He was interviewed again on 02/27/19 at 10:00 AM, verified the license fee was not paid, but said he would pay the fee as soon as possible.


