Personal Care

1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide spoon feeding, or any other eating assistance that is needed based on individual residents needs as indicated on the care plan.

2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide assistance with toileting from supervision to extensive assistance.

3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide assistance with walking, with walker, wheelchair, and gate belt as needed. With supervision to one person assist.

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide assistance with transferring from monitoring to two person assist.

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide assistance with positioning cuing to two person assist.

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide assistance with personal hygiene from supervision to one person assist.

7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will assist, choose and dress the resident appropriately based on his/her needs from supervision/monitoring to two person assist depending on needs.

8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:

Saliem's SR Home will provide assistance with bathing from supervision to two person assist, as needed and based on frequency indicated on the care plan.

Care to residents will always be determined based on their individual needs.

Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is:

The amount of medication given to a resident is the amount ordered by the doctor. We give medications in cup, and/or crush depending on needs. All medication is locked and dispensed according to doctors orders. We also apply creams, wound care, insulin, eye drops, and inhalations all with nurse delegation.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING MEDICATION SERVICES

If a resident has PRN medications a RN will nurse delegate the caregivers.

Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. (WAC 388-76-10405)

The home provides the following skilled nursing services:

PRN Medications, inhalations, and cream (ie. skin care cream for diabetics provided daily).

The home has the ability to provide the following skilled nursing services by delegation:

PRN Medications, glucose monitoring, insulin injections, wound care, eye drops, ear drops, nasal spray, and inhalations.

Staffing
