**Consultation:**

**WAC 388-76-10575 Resident rights Privacy.**

(1) The adult family home must ensure the right of each resident to personal privacy that includes:

(c) Clinical or resident records;

During the tour of the home on 06/27/19 at about 11:51 AM, the residents' list (dated 09/26/16 and 04/14/14) were observed together with the statement of deficiencies (SOD's) that were placed/posted in a visible location. The Entity Representative immediately removed the documents when notified about the residents' violation of privacy.

You Must:

- Begin the process of correcting the deficiency or deficiencies immediately; and
- Complete correction as soon as possible.

You Are Not:

- Required to submit a plan-of-correction for the deficiency or deficiencies found.

The Department May:

- Inspect the home to determine if you have corrected all deficiencies.

You May:

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- Ask for an informal dispute resolution meeting, according to the attached "Informal Dispute Resolution" instructions; and
- Ask questions and provide written information to help clarify or dispute the deficiencies.
