Personal Care

Cuing, monitoring, one person assist, facility is ramp accessible

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

Cueing, monitoring, one person assist

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

Cuing, monitoring, one person assist

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

Set-up, cuing, supervising, one person assist

7. DRESSING

Staffing

- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.

The normal staffing levels for the home are:

- Registered nurse, days and times: As needed
- Licensed practical nurse, days and times: As needed
- Certified nursing assistant or long term care workers, days and times: 7days/5am/9pm, provider ,staff and/or provider and staff. Provider sleeps on site.
- Awake staff at night
- Other: **Provider lives on site.**

Staff is very caring and professional they enjoy taking walks, playing board games,going shopping,etc.

All staff has background/finger print done specialty training and 12 hours of continuing education Cultural or Language Access
