## Personal Care

“Personal care services” means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident’s needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

### 1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide assistance with eating such as, reminders, cutting up, monitoring, hands-on assistance to guide or hand food/drink, to total dependent feeding assistance with all foods/fluids. We will provide therapeutic diets, diabetic diets, mechanical altered, adaptive equipment.**

### 2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide assistance with toileting from setting up, monitoring, encouragement, cueing, assistance with cleansing, care, pads, clothing and or stand-by assistance for transfer to total dependent for all toileting tasks.**

### 3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide assistance with walking using assistive devices, wheelchair, stand-by assistance for safety and monitoring, one person assist to bed bound.**

### 4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide assistance with one person assist transferring, for stand-by, for safety, for encouragement or hands-on guiding,**

### 5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide one person assistance with positioning.**

### 6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide assistance with personal hygiene for set-up, monitoring, encouragement and hands-on assistance to guide through task completion or provide full assistance for the totally dependent.**

### 7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:

**Goden Age Living can provide assistance with dressing, lay out of clothing, help with shoes, socks or total assistance.**

### 8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:

**Goden Age Living will provide full assistance with bathing, we have a roll-in shower room and each resident room has a private bath.**

## Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally

authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. (WAC 388-76-10430)

The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is:

**Goden Age Living can provide medication assistance for one or more medications and for one or more medications that require medication administration through nurse delegation. We order, prepare, monitor, document & store medications in properly locked cabinet or containers.**

**We can provide health monitoring to include blood pressure, pulse rate and other vitals monitoring.**

#### Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. (WAC 388-76-10405)

The home provides the following skilled nursing services:

**Goden Age Living may provide skilled nursing services to include physical, occupational & speech therapies through contracted home health agencies, and hospice care services. These services will need to be paid through the individual's health insurance, private pay or private insurance.**

The home has the ability to provide the following skilled nursing services by delegation:

**Goden Age Living can provide skilled nursing services by delegation to include blood glucose monitoring, insulin injections, cathetar care, oxygen, simple wound care.**

**Goden Age Living can provide services for individuals with moderate to advanced dementia or other memory loss issues. We may provide services for individuals facing hospice/end of life care.**

#### Staffing

The home's provider or entity representative must live in the home, or employ or have a contract with a resident manager who lives in the home and is responsible for the care and services of each resident at all times. The provider, entity representative, or resident manager is exempt from the requirement to live in the home if the home has 24-hour staffing coverage and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home. - The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.
