**WAC 388-76-10415 Food services. The adult family home must:**

(1) Ensure that the safe food handling training requirements of chapter 388-112 WAC are met; and

**This requirement was not met as evidenced by:**

Based on observation, record review and interview the home failed to ensure safe food handling requirements were met when Caregiver #A used her bare hands to hold bell peppers in place as she cut the peppers and mixed them with tuna salad. This placed six of six residents (Resident #1 through Resident #6) at increased risk of contact with bacteria and food borne illnesses.

**Findings include:**

All record reviews and interview occurred on 12/07/2018, unless otherwise noted.


At approximately 11:15 am, observation revealed Caregiver #A in the kitchen holding bell peppers with her bare hand as she cut them with a knife. The Caregiver then mixed the bell peppers in a bowl which contained raw tuna salad ingredients.

Record review revealed Caregiver #A was hired by the home on 11/29/2018 and received a food handling card that expired on 11/31/2020.

In an interview, Entity Representative (ER) reported she was unaware Caregiver #A did not use gloves when touching the bell peppers. ER said she will remind Caregiver #A that use of gloves are required when preparing residents meals.
