**Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation**

**If a resident requires nursing care, the AFH will work with the doctor in ordering Home Health or other agencies if needed, or work with our Nurse Delegator directly.**

The home has the ability to provide the following skilled nursing services by delegation:

**Pavel's AFH LLC provides assistance with any delegated tasks from administering medications to crushing medications to performing wound care, take blood sugars, give insulin, and any other service that is able to be delegated per the WAC.**

**Staffing**

The home's provider or entity representative must live in the home, or employ or have a contract with a resident manager who lives in the home and is responsible for the care and services of each resident at all times. The provider, entity representative, or resident manager is exempt from the requirement to live in the home if the home has 24-hour staffing coverage and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home. (WAC 388-76-10040)

- The provider lives in the home.
- A resident manager lives in the home and is responsible for the care and services of each resident at all times.
- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.

The normal staffing levels for the home are:

- Registered nurse, days and times: **As needed for services or Nurse Delegation.**
- Licensed practical nurse, days and times: \_\_\_\_\_
- Certified nursing assistant or long term care workers, days and times: **24/7 1-2 per shift depending on care needs and how many residents are in the home.**
- Awake staff at night
- Other: **Not 24 Hours Awake Staff at night, but care at night is provided if needed.**

#### Medicaid

We also encourage input from the family on what the Resident enjoys or enjoyed doing during their lifetime and make a reasonable attempt to fulfill our resident's requests.**
