



WAC 388-76-10025 License annual fee.

- (1) The adult family home must pay the license fee that is established in the state's operating budget, as described in RCW 70.128.060 .
- (2) Each year, the home's annual license fee is due during the same month in which the home was initially licensed. For example, if the home was licensed in June, 2010, then the annual licensing fee will be due in June of each year.
- (3) The home must ensure that the department receives the annual license fee when it is due.
- (4) If the home does not pay the fee when it is due, the department will impose remedies.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation, record review and interview, the Provider failed to have a system in place to ensure the department received the annual licensing fee when it was due. This failure placed the residents at risk for living in an unlicensed home.

Findings included:


Record review revealed the annual Adult Family Home (AFH) license fee of \$1350.00 was due on 12/15/2018.

On 02/21/2019, an on-site visit was made to the AFH. The home had 5 residents.

In an interview on 02/21/19, the Provider stated she found the unpaid licensing fee under a pile of papers and would send it to the Department via overnight mail.
