WAC 388-76-10280 Tuberculosis One test. The adult family home is only required to have a person take one test if the person has any of the following:

(1) A documented history of a negative result from a previous two step test done no more than one to three weeks apart; or

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation, interviews and record reviews the adult family home failed to ensure one of two caregivers (Staff A) completed tuberculosis (TB) testing as required. This failure placed six of six current residents at risk of exposure to an infectious organism.

Findings include:

Observation, interviews and record reviews were on 02/26/19, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Staff A was observed during the inspection providing care to six current residents. Review of his employee file showed he was hired 12/12/18. His file included documentation he completed a two-step TB test 05/25/18; however, there was no documentation he completed a test when he was hired to work in the adult home.

During an interview, Staff A confirmed he had not had a TB test when he began working in the adult home. When brought to her attention, the Entity Representative indicated she thought his TB testing was adequate
