

WAC 388-76-10192 Liability insurance required Commercial general liability insurance or business liability insurance coverage. The adult family home must have commercial general liability insurance or business liability insurance that includes:

- (1) Coverage for the acts and omissions of any employee and volunteer;
- (2) Coverage for bodily injury, property damage, and contractual liability;
- (3) Coverage for premises, operations, independent contractors, products-completed operations, personal injury, advertising injury, and liability assumed under an insured contract; and
- (4) Minimum limits of:
 - (a) Each occurrence at five hundred thousand dollars; and
 - (b) General aggregate at one million dollars.

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on record review and interview the Provider failed to maintain business liability insurance for the Adult Family Home (AFH). This deficient practice placed five of five residents (#1, 2, 3, 4, 5) living in the home at risk for not being covered for acts and omissions of any employee and not being covered for bodily injury and/or property damage. Findings included...

Facility record review showed the AFH business liability insurance expired on 09/15/2019.


On 12/11/19 during an interview with Staff E (Provider,) she stated that she was aware the liability insurance coverage for the AFH expired on 09/15/2019. Staff E contacted her insurance company a couple of months prior to the policy expiration to renew the policy. Staff E stated that she did not request any changes to her policy; however, she was informed by the insurance company that the AFH's liability coverage would be cancelled due to the home's citation history with the Department. Staff Member E was provided with an extension of coverage until 11/20/19.

Staff E stated she had been working with an insurance agent daily to find another insurance company for the AFH and that she would notify the Department of coverage as soon as possible.

As of 12/17/2019 the home did not have business liability coverage.
