1. Eating The home will provide eating tasks from cueing, monitoring, and total assistance.	
2. Toileting The home will provide toileting assistance from cueing, monitoring and total assistance.

3. Walking	The home will provide walking assistance from cueing, monitoring and one person assistance.
4. Transferring	The home will provide transfer assistance from cueing, monitoring and total assistance requiring only one person.
5. Positioning	The home will provide positioning assistance from cueing, monitoring and total assistance requiring only one person.
6. Personal Hygiene	The home will provide personal hygiene assistance from reminding, cueing, monitoring and total assistance.
7. Dressing	The home will provide dressing assistance from reminding, cueing, monitoring and total assistance.
8. Bathing	The home will provide bathing assistance from reminding, cueing, monitoring and total assistance.
9.	The home will provide any other personal care not listed above, as listed on client's assessment.

Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. (WAC 388-76-10430)

The home will provide medication assistance as stated in the client's current care plan. All of the homes' caregivers have met the criteria to be delegated in case nurse delegation is required.

Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. (WAC 388-76-10405)

Any skilled Nursing services that cannot be delegated will be performed by a contracted licensed nurse at the home or at a medical facility.

The home will provide the following skilled Nursing services by delegation:

- a. Oral medication,
- b. Topical ointments, lotions, or creams,
- c. Eye drops or ointments,
- d. Ear drops,
- e. Suppositories,

- f. Enemas,
- g. Blood glucose monitoring,
- h. Insulin shots,
- i. Wound care,

Specialty Care Designations

We have completed DSHS approved training for Mental Illnesses and Dementia.

Staffing

The home's provider or entity representative must live in the home, or employ or have a contract with a resident manager who lives in the home and is responsible for the care and services of each resident at all times. The provider, entity representative, or resident manager is exempt from the requirement to live in the home if the home has 24-hour staffing coverage and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home. (WAC 388-76-10040)

The Resident Manager lives in the home.

The normal staffing levels for the home are:

Registered nurse, days and times: Only as needed.

Licensed practical nurse, days and times: Only as needed.

Certified nursing assistant or long term care workers, days and times: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Awake staff at night is not provided.

There is a caregiver on site 24 hours a day. They will normally be asleep between the hours of 10 pm and 6 am. They will check on the residents periodically throughout the night (approximately every 2 to 3 hours). The caregiver will be available to provide care, if needed, during the night.

Cultural or Language Access

The home must serve meals that accommodate cultural and ethnic backgrounds (WAC 388-76-10415) and provide informational materials in a language understood by residents and prospective residents (Chapter 388-76 various sections)

The home caters to clients from all backgrounds, but must be capable of speaking and understanding English.

The home provider speaks English, Tagalog, Ilocano, and Pangasinan.

Medicaid

Activities
The home must provide each resident with a list of activities customarily available in the home or arranged for by the home (WAC 388-76-10530).

Activities range from building models, puzzles, reading books, watching movies/television, listening to music, walking in the park or around the neighborhood (weather permitting), or helping with light household chores such as setting/clearing the table, folding or putting away their own laundry
