## Personal Care

### 1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

**Will provide all assistance levels as required by a resident's care plan, including special dietary restrictions, blending and thickening of foods.**

### 2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

**Will provide all assistance levels as required by a resident's care plan including complete incontinence management.**

### 3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

**We will consider admission of new residents requiring any level of walking assistance up to one person assist.**

### 4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

**We will consider admission of new residents requiring any level of transfer assistance up to a one person transfer assist.**

### 5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

**We will consider admission of new residents requiring any level of positioning assistance up to a one person assist.**

### 6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

**We provide all levels of assistance for personal hygiene.**

### 7. DRESSING

## Medication Services

**Staffing**

The provider, entity representative, or resident manager is exempt from the requirement to live in the home if the home has 24-hour staffing coverage and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home. (WAC 388-76-10040)

- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.

**Medicaid**

**Activities**
