

NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

November 15, 2019

Based on the **amended** Statement of Deficiencies dated **November 15, 2019**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of **Bellevue Adult Family Home LLC, License #753156**, located at **1603 143rd Ave NE, Bellevue, Washington**.

- *The adult family home (AFH) provider, at their own expense, will hire a registered nurse consultant (RNC) not associated previously or currently with the AFH, by December 6, 2019, and familiar with AFH licensing regulations to assist the provider to:*
 - *Develop detailed negotiated care plans for each resident to ensure their care needs are met.*
 - *Review, modify, and implement their Fall Prevention Policy.*
 - *Develop and implement a system that ensures that the provider and all staff have an understanding of:*
 - *Reviewing assessments and negotiated care plans for each resident currently in the home.*
 - *Evaluation of each resident's care needs and the AFH provider's ability and knowledge to meet those care needs.*
 - *Recognizing the signs and symptoms related to residents' change of condition related to falls and injuries.*
 - *Causes of falls and injuries.*
 - *Logging all falls and injuries.*
 - *When to seek medical evaluation from falls and injuries.*
 - *Required reporting of falls and injuries.*
- *The RNC shall be in the home on a weekly basis until all assessments, care plans, fall policy and prevention, and training has been conducted as described above.*
- *The AFH provider must provide a report from the RNC, signed by the AFH provider, regarding what was trained and when completed, to the Department by January 31, 2020.*

- *The AFH provider will provide the RNC with a copy of the November 15, 2019, amended Statement of Deficiencies.*
- *The RNC will be available to answer questions by the Department.*

The AFH provider must post this Notice of Conditions, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area of the AFH, accessible to residents and visitors.

These conditions are effective on **November 15, 2019**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.



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
