



(1) The adult family home must place the following documents in a visible location in a common use area where they can be examined by residents, resident representatives, the department and anyone interested without having to ask for them.

(a) A copy of the most recent inspection report and related cover letter; and

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation, interview, and record review, the adult family home (AFH) failed to place copies of the most recent inspection reports in a visible location in a common area for review of three current residents (Resident #'s 1, 2, and 3), their representatives, the Department, and anyone interested without having to ask for them. This failure placed the residents and/or their representatives at risk of not being able to make an informed decision due to lack of information regarding AFH's compliance with the regulation.

Findings include:

Observation, interview, and record review, occurred on 01-31-2019 unless otherwise noted.

During the tour of the AFH at about 12:31 p.m., the most recent inspection report dated 11-27-2017 was not placed in visible common used areas of the home. The inspection report was in a green binder that was placed inside the kitchen cabinet. The binder had a label "AIMCARE AFH FOR LICENSOR."

When asked why inspection report not placed in common area visible to everyone, the Entity Representative (ER) stated "Because I have that paper there [posting on the board in the common area] that says it's [inspection report] available upon request."
