Personal Care

1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

Set up, Cueing, One on one feeding, Mechanical soft diet ,Pureed Food.

2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

Emerald Forest AFH LLC will provides different levels of toileting ranging from, cueing and toileting reminders, cuieng and monitoring, stand by assist, 1:1 toileting with total toileting and Pericare care .

3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

Stand by assist with or without contact guard. Stand by assist with gait belt assist, Stand by assist with a walker , propelling cheelchair.

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

Stand- by assist with cueing. Full assist with total dependence. Total dependence using a hoyer lift, Total dependence with sit to stand.

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

Every two hours or as needed.

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

Skin care, Shaving, Brushing and dental hygiene, Nail trimming for clients that are not diabetic or on blood thinner,

7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:

Stand by assist, reminders with set up, total dependence with complete assistance.

8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:

A daily bed bath with showers 2-3 days per week and as needed and negotiated in the care plan.

Medication Services

The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is:

All medication is locked up and dispensed to the clients following the doctor's orders and the negotiated care plan . This ranges from handing the medications to the clients with a med cup as an anabler to crushing medication with doctor's approve and delegation. We also apply creams and other ointment

with delegation and administer insulin with delegation. All medications are dispensed following doctor's orders and changes are made only with written doctor's orders.

Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation
