Personal Care

"Personal care services" means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident's needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows:

We provide nutritious home cooked meals. Set up, reminders, cueing, monitoring, cut up foods.

2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows:

Provide toilet safety handles, reminders, prompting, monitoring, cueing, one person assist and clean up

3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows:

Monitoring, cueing and assisting in evacuations, one person assist.

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows:

Cueing, monitoring, one person assist.

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows:

Cueing, monitoring, prompting, one person assist.

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows:

Set up, prompting, supervising,, one person assist.

7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows:

Set up, cueing, supervising, one person assist.

8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows:

Set up, cueing, supervising, proting, on-two person assist; shower chair available.

9. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CARE

Manicures/pedicures, haircuts and styling,, clothes and personal care items shopping provided.

Medication Services

Staffing

The provider, entity representative, or resident manager is exempt from the requirement to live in the home if the home has 24-hour staffing coverage and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home. (WAC 388-76-10040)

- A resident manager lives in the home and is responsible for the care and services of each resident at all times.
- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.

Medicaid

Residents are encouraged to participate in ECCC programs and activities across the street at the community center, or other facilities. We have a garden and beautiful flowers throughout the large front and back yards. Residents enjoy helping with the garden and flowers. Christmas projects and decorating, Easter Egg hunt. We will provide daily activity and a large tv available for sports, tv, movie night in the main area.
