Consultation:

WAC 388-76-10540 Resident rights Disclosure of fees and charges Notice requirements Deposits.

(1) The adult family home must complete the department's disclosure of charges form and provide a copy to each resident admitted to the home.

Disclosure of Fees and Charges paperwork was not completed for sampled Residents (Residents #3 & #4). The Provider has acquired blank copies of the form and instructions for filling out the forms were reviewed with the Provider.

You Must:

- Begin the process of correcting the deficiency or deficiencies immediately; and
- Complete correction as soon as possible.

You Are Not:

- Required to submit a plan-of-correction for the deficiency or deficiencies found.

The Department May:

- Inspect the home to determine if you have corrected all deficiencies.

You May:

- Ask for an informal dispute resolution meeting, according to the attached "Informal Dispute Resolution" instructions; and


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- Ask questions and provide written information to help clarify or dispute the deficiencies.
