Personal Care

"Personal care services" means both physical assistance and/or prompting and supervising the performance of direct personal care tasks as determined by the resident's needs, and does not include assistance with tasks performed by a licensed health professional. (WAC 388-76-10000)

1. EATING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with eating as follows: **Feeding resident who are not able to feed independently, cueing residents who need assistance, pureeing food for those having a hard time eating solid food, supervising each and every resident to meet their nutrition, helping with tube feed**

2. TOILETING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with toileting as follows: **Changing the incontinent residents as needed and providing peri-care, assist residents who cannot go to the bathroom by themselves, cueing other residents to visit the bathroom regularly and just making sure that all their incontinent supplies are well stocked**

3. WALKING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with walking as follows: **Caregivers remind residents to use their assistive devices push their wheelchair if they cannot walk assist the ones that need assistance and just keeping an eye to ensure the residents are safe**

4. TRANSFERRING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with transferring as follows: **Two person assist to heavy transfer residents, use Hoyer when necessary**

5. POSITIONING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with positioning as follows: **Essymon's Devoted Homecare LLC, caregivers are trained to turn residents that cannot turn themselves so as not to develop pressure ulcers. They have to be position in such a way that they are comfortable with the use of pillows. Residents are repositioned after every two hours.**

6. PERSONAL HYGIENE

If needed, the home may provide assistance with personal hygiene as follows: **Caregivers set up residents supplies for those that can do their hygiene. If resident cannot do it for themselves caregiver does it for them such as brushing their teeth, combing/brushing their hair, giving them a shower if they cannot go to the bathroom, bed bath if they can't and also trimming their nails if they're not diabetic. We also put lotion to make sure their skin is hydrated**

7. DRESSING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with dressing as follows: **Assisting residents and making sure they have clean clothes and assisting those residents who are not able to dress independently.**

8. BATHING

If needed, the home may provide assistance with bathing as follows: **Assist residents with shower by taking them to the bathroom and helping them with the whole process monitoring the water temperature, scrubbing their back feet and legs. We also assist with the drying, applying lotion and changing clothes to the residents who are not able do it independently.**

9. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CARE: **Podiatrist are required if they are diabetic**

Medication Services

If the home admits residents who need medication assistance or medication administration services by a legally authorized person, the home must have systems in place to ensure the services provided meet the medication needs of each resident and meet all laws and rules relating to medications. (WAC 388-76-10430)

The type and amount of medication assistance provided by the home is: **Essymon's Devoted Homecare LLC caregivers reminds every resident to take their medications on time, assisting them with administration or oral meds making sure that they are logged properly**

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS REGARDING MEDICATION SERVICES: **Staff are trained to be delegated in various tasks such as giving the syringe if they need insulin injection or putting eye drops to clients eyes**

Skilled Nursing Services and Nurse Delegation

If the home identifies that a resident has a need for nursing care and the home is not able to provide the care per chapter 18.79 RCW, the home must contract with a nurse currently licensed in the state of Washington to provide the nursing care and service, or hire or contract with a nurse to provide nurse delegation. Staffing

- The provider, entity representative, or resident manager does not live in the home but the home has 24-hour staffing coverage, and a staff person who can make needed decisions is always present in the home.

The normal staffing levels for the home are:

Registered nurse, days and times: **As needed**

Licensed practical nurse, days and times:

Certified nursing assistant or long term care workers, days and times: **24 hours/7 days a week**

Cultural or Language Access

Medicaid

Essymon's Devoted HomeCare LLC will accept Medicaid clients if we are aware of the daily rate before admission, and if they will be okay to share a room.

If a private pay client converts to Medicaid, we require a 90 days written notice prior to change.

Activities

The home must provide each resident with a list of activities customarily available in the home or arranged for by the home (WAC 388-76-10530).

The home provides the following:

Residents watch TV shows of their choice. We involve them in the home by having them help fold laundry (those who like). There are times it's not possible to do group activities due to the different levels of care needs. We have large jig-saw puzzles which some clients will put together. Clients are provided with pictures to color. We try to accommodate resident's desires.
