The Department completed a full inspection of your Adult Family Home on March 7, 2019 and found that your home does not meet the adult family home licensing requirements listed below.

**Consultation:**

**WAC 388-76-10845 Emergency drinking water supply. The adult family home must have an on-site emergency supply of drinking water that:**

(2) Is at least three gallons for the home's licensed capacity, every household member, and caregiving staff;

The adult home was licensed for three residents. Three adults and three children lived in the adult home. The minimum amount of emergency water required was 27 gallons. Observation of the adult home's emergency water supply included approximately 22 gallons. The Entity Representative's spouse bought an additional 10 gallons during the inspection.

**WAC 388-76-10895 Emergency evacuation drills Frequency and participation. The adult family home must ensure:**

(1) Emergency evacuation drills occur during random staffing shifts at least every two months; and

Review of the adult home's evacuation drill logs showed all drills were done at 9 a.m. The Entity Representative stated she would vary the times the drills were done.

You Must:

- Begin the process of correcting the deficiency or deficiencies immediately; and
- Complete correction as soon as possible.

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You Are Not:

- Required to submit a plan-of-correction for the deficiency or deficiencies found.

The Department May:

- Inspect the home to determine if you have corrected all deficiencies.

You May:

- Ask for an informal dispute resolution meeting, according to the attached "Informal Dispute Resolution" instructions; and
- Ask questions and provide written information to help clarify or dispute the deficiencies.
