

NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

December 10, 2020

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **November 30, 2020**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of **AA Residential Care LLC**, License #753869, located at **16243 NE 124th Ave, Bothell, Washington**.

- *The adult family home (AFH) provider must hire, at their own expense, a registered nurse consultant (RNC) by December 31, 2020, not currently or previously affiliated with the AFH and familiar with AFH regulations, to assist the provider to develop and implement a responsive care system to identify:*
 - *Causes and prevention of all skin issues, pressure sores/ulcers, promoting healthy skin.*
 - *Signs and Symptoms of infection, and worsening infection.*
 - *Behavioral signs associated of worsening infection.*
 - *How to check vital signs and evaluate the results.*
 - *When to call 911 or access the emergency room.*
 - *Additional communication and coordination with medical professionals when to communicate, document, and how to ensure follow-through with recommendations.*
- *The RNC will ensure all staff, including the provider, are trained in the implementation of the system.*
- *The RNC will contact the field manager upon hire and provide contact information.*
- *The provider will report to the field manager upon completion of the issues covered at the AFH and the progress made.*
- *The AFH provider will give the RNC a copy of the November 12, 2020, Statement of Deficiencies report upon hire.*
- *The AFH provider must post this Notice of Conditions, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area of the AFH, accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **December 10, 2020**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.
