(1) The adult family home must develop and implement a system to ensure the following persons have tuberculosis testing within three days of employment:

(d) Caregiver;

This requirement was not met as evidenced by:

Based on observation, interview and record review, the Adult Family Home (AFH) failed to ensure two of four staff (Staff C, Caregiver and Staff D, Caregiver) completed Tuberculosis testing within three days of hire. This failure placed four of four residents (Resident #1, Resident #2, Resident #3 and Resident #4) at risk for exposure to a communicable disease.

Findings included...

During observation on 11/13/19 at 12:01 PM, Staff C, Caregiver fixed and served lunch to three residents (Resident #1, Resident #2, and Resident #3).

Record review of Staff C's staff records showed the AFH hired Staff C on 09/08/19. Staff C completed a Tuberculosis skin test on 09/29/18 and second step skin test on 09/15/19 with a negative result.

Record review of Staff D, Caregiver staff records showed the AFH hired Staff D on 09/30/19. Staff D completed a Tuberculosis skin test 01/31/18 and second step skin test 03/01/18 with a negative result.

During an interview on 11/13/19 at 12:30 PM, Staff A, Provider stated that they thought the previous Tuberculosis test were okay to use.
