


NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

February 20, 2020

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **February 14, 2020**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of **Earth Angels Inc, License #754229**, located at **5122 Nathan Loop SE, Auburn, Washington**.

- *The adult family home (AFH) provider must hire, at their own expense, an AFH consultant by March 4, 2020, not currently or previously affiliated with the AFH and familiar with AFH regulations, to assist and train the provider on:*
 - *The change of ownership (CHOW) application process and submission of an application.*
 - *How to address PRN medication when medication is not available, understanding and managing residents with diabetes, nurse delegation task, and training on special focus on diabetes.*
 - *How to identify verbal abuse and prevention of verbal abuse.*
 - *Understanding resident rights to include what is dignity and respect, what is considered verbal abuse, and how to ensure a low stress and nurturing environment for a vulnerable adult.*
 - *Understanding how and when to report to the Department and meet all reporting requirements.*
 - *How to develop menus that show nutritious, balanced meals based on resident dietary needs and preferences.*
- *The AFH provider and the consultant will meet with the RCS Field Manager to review the plan of correction and training plan at the field office location, within two weeks of hiring the AFH consultant.*
- *The AFH provider will give the consultant a copy of the Statement of Deficiencies report dated February 14, 2020.*
- *The AFH provider must post this Notice of Conditions, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area of the AFH, accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **February 20, 2020**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.
