AMENDED NOTICE OF IMPOSITION OF CIVIL FINE

Dear Administrator:

This letter constitutes *amended* formal notice of the imposition of a civil fine relating to your assisted living facility, known as **Aegis Senior Living of Shoreline**, located at **14900 1st Avenue NE, Shoreline**, by the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services, pursuant to the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 18.20.190 and Chapter 388-78A of the Washington Administrative Code.

The civil fine is based on the following violations of the RCW and/or WAC as described in the Statement of Deficiencies (SOD) report dated **January 20, 2015**.

WAC 388-78A-2450(1)(a)(2)(e)(h)(iii)(v) – Staff.

The licensee failed to ensure one caregiver had sufficient training to provide care and services designated in the Negotiated Service Agreement (NSA) for one resident.

WAC 388-78A-2160 – Implementation of negotiated service agreement.

The licensee failed to provide the care and services as agreed upon in the negotiated service agreement and ensure implementation of the negotiated service agreement for one resident.

You timely requested a formal administrative hearing to contest the Department's Enforcement Notice dated **January 30, 2015**. Your previous request for hearing is considered applicable to this **amended** notice of the January 30, 2015 enforcement notice. No further action is required by you to appeal this **amended** notice to the Office of Administrative Hearings.

If you choose to withdraw your request for an administrative hearing, the civil fine will be due to the Office of Financial Recovery twenty-eight (28) calendar days after the order dismissing your appeal is entered. Further, if this enforcement action is affirmed in the administrative proceedings, the civil fine is due to the Office of Financial Recovery twenty-eight (28) calendar days after the administrative decision becomes final. When the fine becomes due, you should remit a check for \$4,500.00 payable to the Department of Social and Health Services. The check should be sent to:

If payment has not been received as set forth above, interest will begin to accrue on the balance at the rate of one percent per month. If you do not make payment within twenty-eight (28) days as set forth above, the balance due the department will be recovered.
