

NOTICE OF AMENDED, CONTINUED, CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

February 22, 2021

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **February 16, 2021**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of *Haven in Allyn LLC, License #1953, located at 180 Wheelwright Street, Allyn, Washington.*

- *The licensee must hire, at their own expense, a registered nurse consultant (RNC) by March 1, 2021, not currently or previously affiliated with the facility and familiar with assisted living facility regulations, to assist the administrator in a review and implementation of a system to ensure resident safety by preventing abuse and/or neglect, responding to allegations of resident abuse and/or neglect, and reporting any identified possible allegations of abuse and/or neglect, and implementation of thorough investigative procedures, to determine if abuse and/or neglect has occurred. This must include but not limited to the following:*
 - *Identification of possible abuse and/or neglect per 74.34 RCW.*
 - *Reporting any alleged or suspected abuse and/or neglect consistent with all applicable laws in 74.34 RCW and WAC 388-78A-2630.*
 - *Implementation of any necessary protections of residents during the course of a thorough investigation of possible abuse and/or neglect allegations.*
 - *Training of all staff responsible for completing abuse and/or neglect allegations investigations per WAC 388-78A-2371 and DSHS Assisted Living Guidebook dated February 2018.*
 - *Review and make any modifications to the facility heating pad policy and procedure to include what resident signs and symptoms staff need to observe to prevent a possible burn from heating pad use, and providing specific guidance in each resident's service plan when a resident has negotiated the use of a heating pad.*
 - *Instruct staff to discontinue the use of any heating pads or devices until all staff are retrained on the heating pad policy and procedure, ensuring staff has a clear understanding of heating pad usage for any resident.*
 - *Ensure staff involved in the heating pad incident will not work unsupervised until retrained on heating pad policy and procedure.*
- *The licensee will provide the RNC with a copy of the February 16, 2021, Statement of Deficiencies report.*
- *The RNC must be available to the Department to answer any questions.*
- *The licensee must post this Notice of Conditions of Operation, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **February 22, 2021**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.
