


NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

July 2, 2014

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated June 19, 2014, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of *Cooper George Senior Living, License #2139, located at West 707 5th Avenue, Spokane, Washington.*

- *The facility will hire a nurse consultant, not currently associated with the facility, to provide oversight of medication assistance and administration by July 10, 2014. The expense of the consultant will be the responsibility of the facility.*
- *The consultant will observe and assess the current medication system, and all medication technicians, including those who may be assigned to medication passes. There will be special emphasis on assistance with insulin(s). In-service education will be provided by the consultant to staff, including all medication staff, Administrator, Director of Nursing and all nursing/caregiving personnel regarding insulin and the written protocols regarding reports of medication errors.*
- *At the completion of the in-service education, a signed certificate will be placed in the employee's record to show successful completion.*
- *The licensee will provide a copy of the Statement of Deficiencies dated June 19, 2014 to the nurse consultant.*
- *The facility will post notification that conditions have been imposed on the license, by the Department in a visible place, in a common area of the facility.*

These conditions are effective on **July 2, 2014**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.



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
