**WAC 388-78A-2120 Monitoring residents' well-being. The assisted living facility must:**

- (2) Identify any changes in the resident's physical, emotional, and mental functioning that are a:
- (b) Recurring condition in a resident's physical, emotional, or mental functioning that has previously required intervention by others.
- (3) Evaluate, in order to determine if there is a need for further action:
- (b) Each resident when an accident or incident that is likely to adversely affect the resident's well-being, is observed by or reported to staff persons.
- (4) Take appropriate action in response to each resident's changing needs.

**This requirement was not met as evidenced by:**

Based on interview and record review, the facility failed to monitor and evaluate three out of nine residents, (Resident #1, #6, and #9), who had an observed and/or reported medical incident/change. This failure placed the residents at risk for undergoing adverse effects on their well being due to unmet care needs.

**Findings include:**

Staff A, the Executive Director, reported the facility care staff would place residents on alert monitoring for 72 hours whenever there was any kind of change with the resident (i.e., change or addition in medications, falls, when a resident was evaluated and/or admitted to the hospital, etc).

Resident #1 was admitted to the facility for care and services on [REDACTED] 2014 with diagnoses including [REDACTED]. A progress note written by care staff indicated Resident #1 went to the emergency department on [REDACTED] 2017 for evaluation. Resident #1 was discharged the same day with a diagnosis of [REDACTED].

[REDACTED]. There was no documentation in the file indicating Resident #1 had been placed on alert monitoring after returning back to the facility and after being discharged from the hospital.

Resident #6 was admitted to the facility for care and services on [REDACTED] 2017 with diagnoses including [REDACTED]. According to the file Resident #6 went to see her physician on 9/1/2017. Resident #6's physician wrote an order for "Mirtazapine 15 mg, take one at bedtime every night for sleep." There was no documentation found in the file indicating Resident #6 had been placed on alert monitoring when staff became aware of the new medication order for Resident #6.

Resident #9 was admitted to the facility for care and services on [REDACTED] 2017 with diagnoses including [REDACTED]. A progress note written by care staff and dated [REDACTED] 2017 indicated Resident #9 sustained a fall and complained of pain to the back of the head. Resident #9 was discharged back to the facility on [REDACTED] 2017 with an order to have an MRI of the head on 8/22/2017. There was no documentation in the file indicating Resident #9 went to the MRI appointment, and there was no indication of any results from the MRI.

Staff A, the Executive Director, did not know why these residents had not been placed on alert charting after each of these changes.
