

# NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

June 9, 2021

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated May 26, 2021, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of *Pacifica Senior Living Snohomish, License #2372, located at 1124 Pine Ave, Snohomish, Washington.*

- *The licensee must have a qualified staff member to ensure the facility:*
  - *Review, implement, and train all staff on processes of nursing care, evaluating nursing services, monitoring residents, and taking appropriate action to address resident care needs.*
  - *Review, implement, and train all staff on systems to ensure ongoing assessments are completed accurately, to include staffing necessary to meet all residents' assessed needs.*
  - *Review and update the Negotiated Service Agreement to meet all residents' current needs and preferences to include but not limited to, change of condition or annual assessment. Train staff responsible for implementing the Negotiated Service Agreements.*
  - *Ensure there is an effective system for staff to report residents' change of conditions to the nurse for further evaluation.*
  - *Assess the current medication system to ensure all medications are available as ordered and residents receive medications as prescribed.*
  - *Train all staff to ensure a clear understanding of how to document in the medication delivery system.*
  - *Develop and implement a system to ensure care is coordinated for all residents when home health, hospice, or outside services are utilized.*
  - *Ensure the facility is appropriately staffed to provide care and services to all residents.*
  - *Provide ongoing oversight to ensure the above conditions are implemented.*
- *The facility will provide weekly reports to the Field Manager, beginning on June 21, 2021, which includes development and implementation of the processes and systems related to the conditions above including staff training and how oversight will be provided.*
- *The licensee must post this Notice of Conditions of Operation, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **June 9, 2021**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.
