

# NOTICE OF CONTINUED CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

February 1, 2021

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **January 19, 2021**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of *Rose Pointe Assisted Living, License #2452, located at 13013 E Mission Ave, Spokane Valley, Washington.*

- *Implement acceptable standards of practice for infection control, in accordance with current CDC guidelines, for transmission-based precautions, including contact precautions, droplet precautions, and airborne precautions for staff and residents, including identification and management of ill residents, appropriate use of personal protective equipment (PPE), and comprehensive screening process for visitation.*
- *Provide adequate supplies of PPE and ensure that healthcare personnel are trained to utilize PPE in accordance with current CDC guidelines and local health jurisdiction recommendations.*
- *Work with the Local Health Jurisdiction to identify, prevent, and control exposure to and spread of COVID-19. Implement and comply with the Local Health Jurisdiction guidance and instructions.*
- *Develop and implement processes for screening all persons coming into the facility in accordance with current CDC guidelines and Local Health Jurisdiction recommendations.*
- *Ensure staff are trained and following CDC guidelines for cleaning and disinfection for facilities with COVID-19.*
- *Ensure there is documentation that all staff are trained on all of the above conditions.*
- *The licensee must post this Notice of Conditions of Operation, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **February 1, 2021**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.



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
