

NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

May 3, 2021

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **April 20, 2021**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of *Woodland Village, License #2512, located at 2100 SW Woodland Circle, Chehalis, Washington.*

- *The licensee will hire, at the licensee's expense, on or by May 15, 2021, a Registered Nurse Consultant (RNC) not previously or currently associated with the facility and familiar with infection control and prevention, to assist the facility as follows:*
 - *Work with the local health jurisdiction to implement acceptable standards of practice for infection control, in accordance with current guidelines, local health jurisdiction recommendations and Governor Proclamations for staff and residents. To include:*
 - *Develop and implement training for staff relating to:*
 - *The proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE) necessary to protect staff and residents, and when it is to be worn.*
 - *Ensuring staff are fit tested for N95 respirators, and provided all necessary PPE.*
 - *The proper way to don and doff personal protective equipment (PPE).*
 - *Conducting COVID-19 screenings for staff, visitors and residents, identifying signs and symptoms of COVID-19, and what to do in the event a screening results in a positive response.*
 - *Documenting all staff have been properly trained on all infection prevention and control measures related to COVID-19.*
 - *Implement a process to screen all persons entering the facility.*
 - *Develop and implement methods to monitor and ensure ongoing compliance with the above.*
 - *The licensee must post this Notice of Conditions of Operation, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area accessible to residents and visitors.*

These conditions are effective on **May 3, 2021**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.
