


# NOTICE OF AMENDED CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

August 8, 2017

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **July 24, 2017**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following amended conditions on the license of *McGee Guest Home, License #800, located at 21520 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue East, Spanaway, Washington.*

- *The licensee will hire a Registered Nurse Consultant by August 21, 2017 that is familiar with the Assisted Living Medication Assistance rules and regulations to assist the licensee to:*
  - *Assess the current medication system and if necessary, develop a new system or modify the existing system to comply with all applicable medication regulations for assisted living facilities to include WAC 388-78A-2210.*
  - *Train all current and oncoming staff performing as medication technicians in the new or updated medication system to ensure a clear understanding of medication delivery to residents.*
  - *Audit the medication delivery system until such a time as the facility can demonstrate compliance with WAC 388-78A-2210.*
- *The licensee will provide the Consultant with copies of the May 26, 2017 and July 24, 2017 Statement of Deficiencies report.*
- *The Consultant will be available to the Department for questions.*
- *The licensee must post this Notice of Amended Conditions of Operation, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area.*

These conditions amend the conditions that were imposed on your license on **June 9, 2017** and are effective on **August 8, 2017**, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.
