

AMENDED NOTICE OF CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

March 14, 2018

Based on the Statement of Deficiencies dated **November 1, 2018**, the Department of Social and Health Services imposes the following conditions on the license of *McGee Guest Home, License #800, located at 21520 82nd Ave E, Washington.*

- *The licensee will hire a Licensed Nurse Consultant familiar with the Assisted Living Medication Assistance rules and regulations by March 31, 2019, to assist the licensee to:*
- *Assess the current medication system and if necessary, develop a new system or modify the existing system to comply with all applicable medication regulations for assisted living facilities to include WAC 388-78A-2210 with a focus on medication transcription, medication re-ordering, medication reconciliation and documentation medications were dispensed.*
- *Train all current and incoming staff performing as medication technicians in the new or updated medication system to ensure a clear understanding of medication delivery to residents.*
- *The Licensed Nurse Consultant shall be on-site to provide over-site and supervision of the medication delivery system implementation three days a week for three weeks, two day a week for three weeks, then weekly until all staff assisting with medication assistance can demonstrate ongoing compliance.*
- *The licensee will provide the Consultant with a copy of the November 1, 2018, Statement of Deficiencies.*
- *The consultant will be available to the Department for questions.*
- *The licensee must post this Notice of Conditions of Operation, with the license, in a visible location in a common use area.*

These amended conditions are effective on March 14, 2019, and remain in effect until lifted by formal Department of Social and Health Services notice.

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
