Providers: YOUR Medicaid billing moves to ProviderOne on January 15, 2015*

Billing and payment for social service Medicaid claims is moving to ProviderOne in January, 2015. Here are some key dates:

- **Now:** Enrollment training continues
- **December 1, 2014:** Training available on Billing and Claims Management
- **December 22, 2014:** Final SSPS invoices are mailed
- **January 5, 2015:** **ALL PROVIDERS MUST BE ENROLLED** in ProviderOne
- **January 15, 2015:** **PROVIDERS START BILLING** for Medicaid services in ProviderOne (weekly payment option available!)

** Individual Providers represented by the SEIU will continue to use SSPS through 2015.*

Multiple Provider Numbers are a Thing of the Past

Are you one of the providers that had multiple SSPS numbers to track your different Medicaid Services? (For example, maybe you have multiple Adult Family Homes, or provide nurse delegation services and residential care.) If yes, you'll see a change with ProviderOne.

Now, each provider will have only *one* provider number. However, providers can have *multiple locations* to specify different places of business, or different types of services provided under different contracts. Providers will bill – and be paid - separately for each location.
