



Training Now Available on Your New Online Medicaid Billing System!

Your January Medicaid services must be claimed online using the ProviderOne system. Prepare now - complete the enrollment steps and take the training.*

Training is now available specifically for Social Service Medical Providers

Social Service Medical providers include nurse delegators, adult day health, physical / speech / occupational therapists, and other providers who have credentials and licenses from the Washington State Department of Health.

URGENT - If you haven't yet [enrolled](#) in ProviderOne, you MUST take action!

Social Service Medical providers must obtain a National Provider Identifier (NPI) to enroll in ProviderOne, and submit claims for Medicaid services. *It can take up to 14 days for your NPI to be assigned.* Please visit <https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/NPPES> to apply for your NPI.

You must also complete a Core Provider Agreement with the Health Care Authority before being able to submit Medicaid claims in ProviderOne. This can also take several days to process. If you have not completed a Core Provider Agreement, please contact us immediately!

Important Dates:

December 22, 2014: Final SSPS invoices are mailed

January 5, 2015: ALL PROVIDERS MUST BE ENROLLED in ProviderOne

January 15, 2015: PROVIDERS START BILLING ONLINE for Medicaid Services using ProviderOne
