The Division of Child Support (DCS) has a DCS Most Wanted Internet site. The Internet address is www.mostwanted.dshs.wa.gov. The site is a tool used to aid DCS with difficult collection cases or cases where we cannot locate the noncustodial parent.

If you want your case posted to the site, please do the following.

1. Complete this form. **Except for your signature, print all responses. Use blue or black ink only.**
2. Provide a photograph of the noncustodial parent. **DCS cannot post your case to the internet site without a photograph.**
3. Return this **completed form and the photograph** to the DCS address listed on page 2.

Custodial Parent's Consent for DCS Most Wanted Internet Site Posting

I voluntarily give my consent to DCS to post information about my child support case on the DCS Most Wanted Internet site. This information includes:

- 1. The number and ages of my child(ren).
- 2. The amount of child support owed for my child(ren). This includes past-due and current support amounts.
- 3. Information about the noncustodial parent.

I understand that:

- 1. I must provide a photograph of the noncustodial parent.
 - a. DCS will not accept my application without a photograph of the noncustodial parent.
 - b. DCS will post only the noncustodial parent's picture. (If other individuals appear in the photograph, DCS will remove everyone except the noncustodial parent.)
- 2. If DCS posts my case to the Internet site, DCS decides how long the information remains posted. If I notify DCS in writing that I want to withdraw permission to have my case posted, DCS will remove my case from the site.
- 3. If the noncustodial parent has more than one child support case, all of the custodial parents involved must agree to have the noncustodial parent posted to the DCS Most Wanted site.
- 4. Even if my case meets all conditions for posting to the Internet site, DCS may choose not to post my case.

I certify (or declare) under penalty of perjury, under the laws of the state of Washington, that the contents of this form are true and correct and that the photograph provided is a photograph of the noncustodial parent.
