Dear Ms. Bellon:

Pursuant to RCW 90.58.090 (2)(e), on October 21, 2019, the Lakewood City Council adopted Ordinance 718, which incorporated the Ecology-recommended changes to Lakewood's 2019 Shoreline Master Program Periodic Review that provide further clarity to aid applicants and practitioners during implementation. A copy of the updated Lakewood SMP is attached hereto and can also be viewed at www.lakewoodsmp.org.

In addition to the Ecology-recommended changes, the City Council adopted one more edit affecting SMA Restoration Policies policy language, to add Edgewater Park to a list of water bodies, at Chapter 3, Section 6.c.11:

11) American Lake North Park, Edgewater Park, Harry Todd Park, Springbrook Park and Open Space, and Chambers Creek Canyon Park should be targeted for the use of environmentally friendly materials and design during the future planned development of recreational facilities.
