Description of proposal: **The proposal is to conduct the periodic review and update of the City of Winlock Shoreline Master Program and adopt it by Resolution No. [2021-04] following Washington State Department of Ecology approval. The proposed amendments deal with recent changes in RCWs and WACs that set forth policies, development standards and procedures for uses and activities within the shoreline jurisdiction of the City of Winlock.**
