# History of MTCA and CPG

- CPG is in Ecology's capital budget
- Ecology must request new appropriation for CPG every two years
- Appropriation request = the carry forward level of the previous biennium + the fiscal growth factor



# History of MTCA and CPG

- CPG rule revised in 2000
- Established an 80/20 split of the local toxics appropriation for CPG
- 80% of the appropriation goes to county public works for planning and program implementation
- 20% firewalled for local health departments.





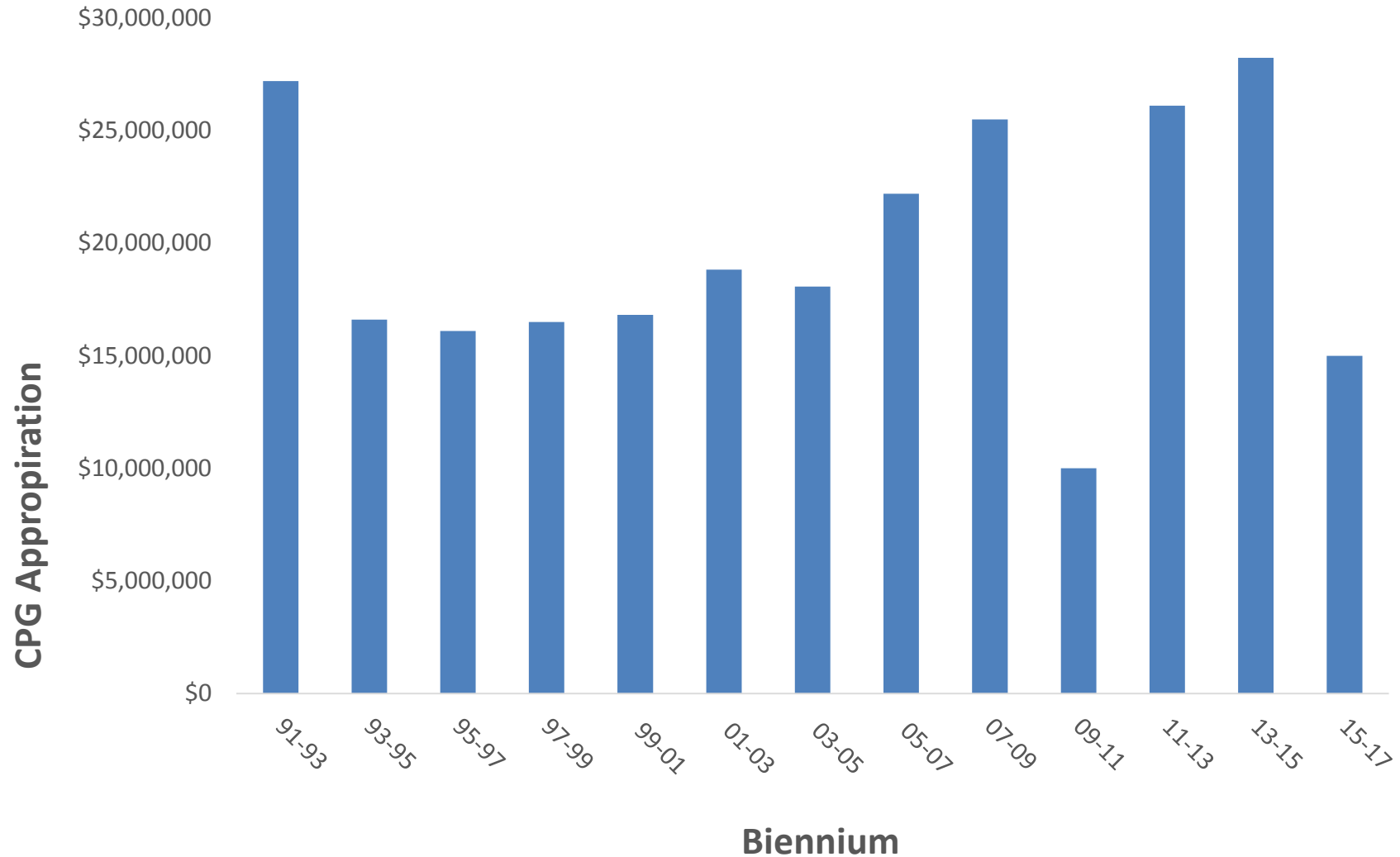
# CPG 15-17 Biennium

# CPG: 15 – 17 Biennium

- CPG requested \$29.6 million for 2015-17
- Governor accepted the request
- Applicants submitted proposals through EAGL
- Legislature approved \$15 million funded through SBCA

- Chapter 173-312 WAC Coordinated Prevention Grants
- Chapter 173-313 WAC Solid Waste Enforcement Grants



# Reasons for amending Chapter 173-312

- The Attorney General recommended updating the rule for aligning grant cycle after we began awarding grants on a fiscal year basis in 2011.
- Stakeholders have requested clarification and other modifications including updating the name of the program.
- We want more flexibility to focus funding on projects that yield the best return on the investment.



# Reasons for amending Chapter 173-312

- Grants and Loans (EAGL) web based grants management program as the preferred tool for grant application and management.
- We want to improve support for coordinated planning across local jurisdictions.

# Timeframe for Revising Chapter 173-312 & 173-313

Rulemaking Timeline	
Date (tentative)	Activity
April – June 30, 2016	Hold stakeholder advisory committee meetings. Develop preliminary rule for public release.
July 2016	Hold public workshop(s) on preliminary draft.
July – August 2016	Consider input and prepare rule for formal proposal
August 2016	Announce formal rule proposal (file CR-102)
September 2016	Formal public hearings
October 2016	End public comment period
October 2016	Review public comments and prepare adoption packet
Early November	Adopt rule (file CR-103)
Early December	Rule effective
