Project Name: Skokomish River Basin Ecosystem Restoration

Applicant: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Seattle District

Project Description: Restoration activities include the Confluence Levee removal, placement of engineered log jams and large woody debris, side channel reconnection, and wetland restoration. Activities conducted on Tribal Properties will be regulated by EPA.

Project Location: Multiple properties along the Skokomish River, North Fork Skokomish River, South Fork Skokomish River, side channel (RM 4—5.6) and Vance Creek; NW Quarter Section 17 & 18, Township 21 North, Range 4 West; Mason County, Washington.
