

Oil Spill Contingency Plan Holder **BP Cherry Point Refinery** submitted a significant update to Ecology requiring public comment on June 6, 2024.

Under WAC 173-182, public notice, review, and comment periods are required for permanent significant changes to approved plans as required in WAC [173-182-142](#). The changes which are considered significant for the plan update are:

- Changes in normal operating procedures as described below:
 - For facilities, **changes in the oil types handled**; permanent changes in storage capacity; changes in handling or transporting of any product; permanent changes in oil processing; and

In Appendix A and F, the plan includes “Coker Feedstock”, a Group V oil, to products handled at the facility. Public comment and review is limited to this significant update to the plan.
